### Weekly Progress (10 - 17 May)

We have now given a total of 543,988 vaccines (a combination of 1st and 2nd doses) across our Health Board area. We have now vaccinated 73.8% of 30-39 year olds, 80% of second doses to those aged 65-69 years and on the weekend we started to vaccinate under 30s.

#### Not leaving anyone behind...



If you are 40 years and older and have not received your COVID-19 vaccine, we are holding a drop in clinic between 11am – 3pm on 22nd May. This session is run by our outreach team and is specifically targeted for harder to reach communities, however anyone is invited to attend if they haven't yet had their 1st vaccine appointment.

The session will take place at the Community House, Eton Road on the corner of Eton and Corporation Road, Newport, NP19 0BL.

No appointment necessary, however you will need to bring ID with you.


