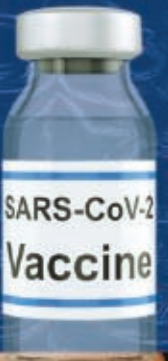

Weekly Progress (1 - 7 June)



We have now given a total of 652,298 vaccines (a combination of 1st and 2nd doses) across our Health Board area. More than 8 in 10 of the Gwent adult population have now received their first dose of Covid vaccine.

As a Health Board we are so proud of the vaccination teams at our Mass Vaccination

Centres, GP Practices, Pharmacies and the mobile teams who have been busy vaccinating, as well as all the staff behind the scenes who have helped our vaccination programme run as successfully and efficiently as it has. 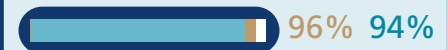
Total number of Covid-19 vaccines given across our Health Board area (combination of 1st and 2nd doses)

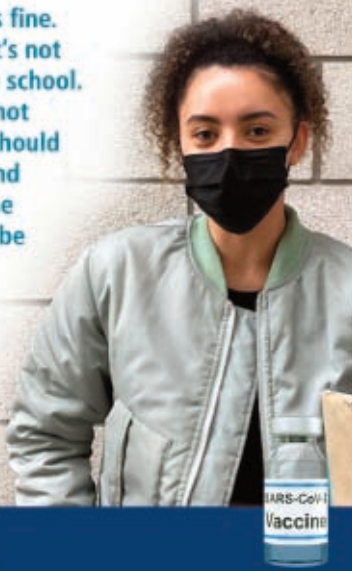

Second Doses

Those aged 55-59 years should have now received their invite for their second dose and those aged 50-54 years will start to receive their invite over the next few weeks.

If you received your 1st dose of Pfizer between 7th December 2020 – 31st March 2021 and not yet received your invite for your second vaccine, please complete the following form on our website:

If you received your 1st dose of AstraZeneca at a Mass Vaccination Centre between the dates of 4th January 2021 – 31st March 2021 and not yet received an invite for your 2nd dose, please complete the following form on our website: <https://abuhb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccine/overdue-astrazeneca-second-dose/>

If you received your first dose of AstraZeneca vaccine at your GP practice, they will be in contact directly to arrange your second dose.



Booking Telephone Number

All adults living in the Aneurin Bevan University Health Board area should have now received an offer of vaccination at one of our sites. However, the programme is dedicated to ensuring nobody is left behind. Therefore, if for some reason you are yet to receive an appointment offer or you have previously declined or not been able to attend for your first vaccination please get in contact as soon as possible. Our booking team are on hand ready to allocate you an appointment at one of our Mass Vaccination Centres. Having the vaccine is the best way to protect yourself, your loved ones and our community from COVID-19.
