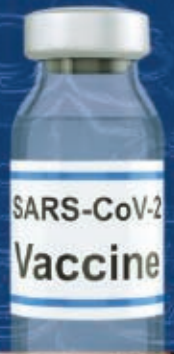

Weekly Progress (7 - 14 June)



We have now given a total of 690,028 vaccines (a combination of 1st and 2nd doses) across our Health Board area. We have now invited all those aged 18 years and over for their first vaccine appointment with 86% of the Gwent population receiving their first dose of Covid vaccine.

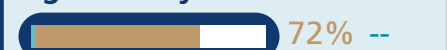

On Saturday 26th June we will be holding walk-in vaccination clinics at our Mass Vaccination Clinics at both Newport Centre and Ebbw Vale. This walk-in clinic is for first doses only and is open to anyone aged 18 years and above as both Pfizer and AstraZeneca will be available. No appointment is necessary, however you will need to bring ID.

Vaccinations in hot weather

Second Doses

Those aged 50-54 years should have now received their invite for their second dose and those aged 45-49 years will start to receive their invite over the next few weeks.

If you received your 1st dose of Pfizer between 7th December 2020 – 11th April 2021 and not yet received your invite for your second vaccine, please complete the following form on our website:

If you received your 1st dose of AstraZeneca at a Mass Vaccination Centre between the dates of 4th January 2021 – 11th April 2021 and not yet received an invite for your 2nd dose, please complete the following form on our website: <https://abuhb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccine/overdue-astrazeneca-second-dose/>

If you received your first dose of AstraZeneca vaccine at your GP practice, they will be in contact directly to arrange your second dose.

All adults living in the Aneurin Bevan University Health Board area should have now received an offer of vaccination at one of our sites. However, the programme is dedicated to ensuring nobody is left behind. Therefore, if for some reason you are yet to receive an appointment offer or you have previously declined or not been able to attend for your first vaccination please get in contact as soon as possible. Our booking team are on hand ready to allocate you an appointment at one of our Mass Vaccination Centres. Having the vaccine is the best way to protect yourself, your loved ones and our community from COVID-19.
