## Weekly Progress (28 June - 5 July)



We have now vaccinated **87%** of the Health Board adult population with first doses offered to everyone aged 18 years and over.

We are also progressing well with second doses with 89% of over 40s being fully vaccinated.

## Vaccine Boosters

Following last week's announcement from the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisations regarding the next phase of the Mass Vaccination Programme, we would like to reassure our residents that all those that meet the criteria for the booster vaccination will be offered an appointment within the appropriate timeframes. From the beginning of the programme, Aneurin Bevan University Health Board and our General Practitioner partners have followed the guidance from the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisations vaccinating our residents in priority group order ensuring those at higher risk are protected first. We will continue to follow the Welsh Government strategy to ensure our residents are offered protection as quickly and as safely as possible.

We ask that you do not contact us to request an appointment for your booster.

**If you still haven't received your first dose of vaccine or if you received your first dose before 30th April and haven't yet received an invite for your second vaccination, please contact our booking centre on 0300 303 1373 to arrange your appointment.**




Age 60-64 years



Age 55-59 years




Age 50-54 years





## Vaccine Certificates

**Please be aware that the Health Board or your GP cannot provide you with a vaccine certificate, this has to be requested from the Welsh Government.**

Check entry requirements such as COVID-19 tests and isolation for countries that you intend to visit (on GOV.UK).

You will still need to follow other rules when travelling, such as pre-departure testing.

The NHS COVID Pass allows you to show others that you've received a COVID-19 vaccine when travelling abroad.

You can get a digital NHS COVID Pass if:

- you were vaccinated in Wales
- you are aged 16 or over

It is recommended that you get the digital COVID Pass rather than the paper version. You will be able to show this on your phone, tablet or laptop.

People in Wales cannot currently use the NHS App to access their NHS COVID Pass and vaccination status.

You can get your vaccination status in paper format if:

- two weeks have passed since you completed a full course of the COVID-19 vaccine
