Weekly Progress (12 - 19 July)



We have now vaccinated 88% of the Health Board's adult population with first doses and are progressing well with second doses with 85% of over 30s being fully vaccinated.

We are currently vaccinating 30-39 year olds, and those aged 25-29

should expect to receive their invite for their second dose over the next few weeks.

If you still haven't received your first dose of vaccine or if you received your first dose before 31st May and haven't yet received an invite for your second vaccination, please contact our booking centre on 0300 303 1373 to arrange your appointment where you will be given an appointment within 72 hours, sometimes appointments can be arranged for the same day.

Second doses...

The 1st dose of Covid vaccine provides estimated 25-36% protection against the Delta variant, protecting against being symptomatic. The 2nd dose raises the level of protection up to 77-82%. Therefore it is important that you receive both doses of the Covid vaccination for maximum protection.

We are currently vaccinating those aged 30-39 years with their 2nd dose and those aged 25-29 years will start to receive their 2nd dose invite over the next few weeks.

Anybody over the age of 40 years will have an 8 week interval between their vaccines.
