## Weekly Progress (19 - 26 July)

We have now vaccinated 88% of the Health Board adult population with first doses and are progressing well with second doses with 87% of over 30s being fully vaccinated.

We are now sending out invites for second doses to those aged 18-29 years, so you should expect to receive your invite over the next few weeks.

### JCVI issues advice on COVID-19 vaccination of children and young people

Following the recent announcement and recommendations from the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisations regarding the approval of the COVID-19 vaccination of those aged between 12 and 17 years who are at higher risk from COVID-19, and all those within twelve weeks of turning 18 years old will now be eligible to receive the vaccine.

We will be contacting all those that meet the updated criteria to offer an appointment over the next few weeks. We ask that you do not contact us to request an appointment, but we do ask that yours or your child's details held with your GP Practice are up-to-date. We will aim to notify all individuals at least one week prior to their appointment and letters will be sent to your registered home address held with your GP.

Please be aware that we will be running dedicated vaccination clinics for this age group between 9<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> August, details of your appointment will be sent to your registered address and should be received by the end of next week. If you are unable to make your allocated appointment we will facilitate an alternative offer. Getting the vaccine is the best way to protect yourself and loved ones from COVID-19.

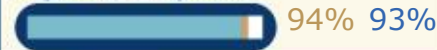

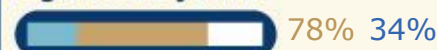
