We have vaccinated 89% of the Health Board adult population with first doses and now have 85% of our over 18s fully vaccinated with two doses.

Farewell Newbridge... hello Pontllanfraith!

The Mass Vaccination Centre (MVC) is finishing in Newbridge Leisure Centre this week and transferring to Pontllanfraith Leisure Centre. Patient clinics will resume from 2nd September 2021.

Since starting at Newbridge MVC on 30th January 2021, over 157,000 vaccinations have been delivered, which is a phenomenal achievement and testament to the efforts of all those involved. The MVC has worked extremely well and has been well-received by those who have attended. We are incredibly grateful to local authority leisure staff, who have been instrumental in supporting the smooth operation at Newbridge in fulfilling car parking and meet and greet duties, and to Newbridge School who afforded us the opportunity to use the sports hall for the vaccination programme.

We look forward to continuing our partnership with Caerphilly County Borough Council in establishing the MVC in Pontllanfraith.
