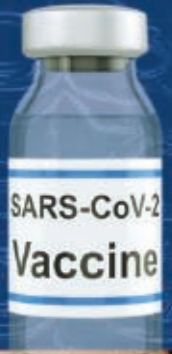

Weekly Progress (1-8 November)



We have now given a total of **107,140** booster and third dose vaccinations across our Health Board area.

We have administered booster vaccination to 20,300 of people aged 80 and over, 20,463 Health and Social Care staff, and 4,580 care home workers.

Booster Appointments

Residents will be invited to attend for COVID-19 booster vaccination by letter, in the order they receive their second dose.

Everyone who received their **second dose** of COVID-19 vaccination on or before **30th April 2021** should now have been invited for their booster vaccine. If for any reason you have not received an invite, please fill in the form on our website, we will check your previous vaccination record and eligibility for the booster dose. If you are due a booster vaccination, our team will contact you.

Vaccinating 12-15 year olds

Almost six in ten people aged 12-15 years old, in the Aneurin Bevan University Health Board area, have already come forward for their first dose of vaccine.
