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This booklet is about plans for the way we give services for people who need ear implants.



There are two types of hearing implants, doctors call these:

- Cochlear Implants
- Bone Conduction Hearing Implants (BCHI)

Many people also call a BCHI a
Bone Anchored Hearing Aid (BAHA)



Someone may need a hearing implant because of:



deafness in one or both ears



 hearing loss due to the shape or size of the ear canal



hearing loss due to a medical reason



The implant is placed by a team who have a lot of training and experience.






Bone Conduction Hearing Implants

- Neath Port Talbot, Swansea
- University Hospital Wales, Cardiff
- Royal Gwent Hospital, Newport



In 2019 the Cochlear service in Bridgend closed.



All patients needing a Cochlear implant since 2019 are seen in Cardiff.



There was no change for people needing a BCHI.



How Could These Services Be Better?

We talked to experts and patients.



We talked to the clinical team who give these services.



We looked at information about hearing implant services in:

- South East Wales
- South West Wales
- South Powys





Last year

- 48 people had a Cochlear Implant
- 27 people had a Bone
 Conduction Hearing Implant



Sometimes people have to wait too long to have a hearing implant.



Not all hospitals that place hearing implants have all of the right team to do this.



The number of Cochlear implant patients is small.

The number of BCHI patients is smaller.



There are not enough staff.



It is sometimes difficult for services to meet their standards.

Our Ideas For Implant Services



We would like to have a single implant centre for South East Wales, South West Wales and South Powys.



A single centre would be able to provide a high quality service for Cochlear and BCHI implants.



We want this centre to be for adults and children.



It will be easier to employ and keep staff in a single centre.



Skills can be kept at the highest level with more implants being done.



It is easier for a bigger centre to cope with emergencies, changes and some staff being ill or leaving.



Moving all the hearing implant operations to one hospital will not change other local services.
