- 5. Over 12 months

Please note as per the Health Boards previous response the figures are the officially reported monthly DTOC figures that the Health Board submits to Delivery Unit/Welsh Government. For clarity, the submitted figures are the validated position, validated in conjunction with Local Authority colleagues and are 'as at' a census point (third Wednesday of the month) and will reconcile with those reported nationally via WG.

In the past financial year (2022/23) of all the patients who were discharged, how many waited the following periods of time between being deemed medically fit for discharge, and actually being discharged?

- 6. 0-3 months
- 7. 3-6 months
- 8. 6-12 months
- 9. Over 12 months

A patient is only considered to be a POCD 48-hours after they are deemed to be clinically optimised (previously called medically fit) and are only recorded and reported as a POCD from that point onwards (hence, not all discharges will be captured on the POCD system). Please find below the total discharges from November 2022 to March 2023.
