Aneurin Bevan University Health Board is an NHS organisation providing health services for the residents of Aneurin Bevan University Health Board (Blaenau Gwent, Caerphilly, Monmouthshire, Newport, Torfaen) free at the point of need. The Health Board does not charge individuals for treatment.

3. Name of consultant urological surgeon and outpatient fees before surgery of this type.

The Health Board provides circumcisions for medical/clinical reasons only. A GP referral would be required for this service. A referral would be made to the relevant department and added to the list of the most appropriate consultant. As above, the Health Board provides care for its residents free at the point of need.
