

Please may each of your health boards provide the number of 0–10 year-olds taking antidepressants, including 10-years olds and the number of 10-19 year-olds taking antidepressants.

Can these statistics be broken down year by year from the year 2010 until November 2022 please?

IE in 2010 there were x amount of 0-year-olds, there were x amount of 1-year-olds and so on for each year (I.e. 2011, 2012) and so up until 19-year-olds.

The Health Board can confirm that the Medicines Management system does not hold patient level prescribing data and so is unable to report prescribing of antidepressants to age ranges.
