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## **Your Request**

You requested the following:

We would like to have the data please to show how many people (all ages) were seen in a&e following Trampolining accidents in the 12 months (1st January to 31st December) of the following years:

Was there a breakdown in how serious the accidents would have been - and if so, is this available in data format?

Lastly, is there a breakdown of whether these accidents were on garden trampolines, trampoline clubs or trampoline parks please? If so, could we have the breakdown showing this please?

## Our response

We have searched our records and confirm that there is no formal category to classify accidents directly associated with trampolines and we are therefore unable to provide conclusive data which includes seriousness or locations for these presentations. However, the table below provides the number of attendances at an Emergency Department or Minor Injury Unit where the terms 'trampoline' or 'trampolining' is mentioned within the triage notes.

Please note that the Grange University Hospital opened in November 2020 and therefore, no data is available prior to that date.
