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What criteria are you using to roll our vaccinations? My wife and I are 80 years of age still waiting for vaccine you are obviously not using an alphabetical method so when will it be our turn?

We have been self isolating as per instructions since March now that Wales is behind with vaccines is not what we would wish to hear! Can you give us some positive news regarding this please!

The Health Board are prioritising vaccinations in line with the Joint Committee Vaccination & Immunisation (JVCI) and we are working our way through the nine priority groups that have been identified. Further information regarding vaccine eligibility can be found via the following link:

We have a plan, subject to vaccine supply, to offer vaccinations to people in the priority groups 1-4 by mid-February, followed by the other groups by the spring:

- 1. Residents in a care home for older adults and their carers
- 2. All those 80 years of age and over and frontline health and social care workers
- 3. All those 75 years of age and over
- 4. All those 70 years of age and over and clinically extremely vulnerable individuals (i.e. those on the Shielding Patient List)
- 5. All those 65 years of age and over
- 6. All individuals aged 16 years to 64 years with underlying health conditions which put them at higher risk of serious disease and mortality
- 7. All those 60 years of age and over
- 8. All those 55 years of age and over
- 9. All those 50 years of age and over
