- for CT please write the number of slices
- for MRI please write the Tesla
- for Fluoroscopy please write if its fixed or mobile, flat panel or image intensifier
- for Mammography please write if it is static or trailer, 2D or 3D
- for Nuclear please write if its PET, PET-CT, PET-MRI, SPECT or SPECT-CT,
- for Ultrasound please write the capability (2D, 3D, 4D)
- for X-ray please write if it is static or mobile, CR, DR or retrofitted
