

**Vaccination Centres - I understand the Aneurin Health Board are using Local Council Premises for the vaccination**

**Can you please confirm if the Councils in Aneurin Bevan Trust are providing the accommodation free of charge and if not can you please define the cost charged by each individual authority to the Health Board: Caerphilly, Blaenau Gwent, Monmouth, Torfaen, Newport and Powys**

We can confirm that Aneurin Bevan University Health Board are in discussions with each of the five local authorities Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council, Caerphilly County Borough Council, Monmouthshire County Council, Newport City Council and Torfaen County Borough Council, to find suitable premises for use as COVID-19 vaccination centres. Costs for use of the respective premises are still under negotiation and therefore, cannot be provided at the current time.

Whilst the Health Board covers South Powys, for the purposes of the mass vaccination programme, you would need to contact Powys Teaching Health Board for information on the support offered by Powys County Council.
