A rota is used to form a blueprint of compliance or rules based on working patterns for a department, team or unit e.g. to create junior doctor rotas compliant to the 2016 Junior Doctor contract. Rotas are not to be confused with rosters (when shifts are allocated to workers)

Medirota – Medical CLWRota – Anaesthetics Both software/systems are provided by supplier Rotamap

13. Does the trust have any projects or procurements for a rota or rostering software on-going or scheduled in the next 12 months?

ABUHB are currently completing a review of the current E-Systems strategy and the number and variety of medical e-systems currently in use within the Health Board. Work is ongoing in reviewing some of the systems and assessing other solutions on offer in the market. This strategy review covers job planning, e-rostering, locum/bank, agency, direct engagement, managed services etc. It is likely that there will be projects/procurements that result from this review, but at this stage nothing can be confirmed.

14. If yes, list the upcoming projects or procurements and their planned start dates?

As mentioned above, it is likely that there will be projects/procurement processes commencing in the next 12 months, however, specific requirements and start dates are not yet known.

15. In order to participate in a rota or rostering tender, what is the process?

This is dependent on the route to market and procurement process selected by the Health Board. A review of the procurement options and routes to market will be carried out prior to the commencement of the process. There will be an opportunity to carry out a mini competition via an appropriate framework, if this option is selected then only the suppliers qualified on the framework would be invited to submit a tender. There is also the option to carry out an open market tender, where any interested providers would be invited to bid.

16. Is your rota supplier the same as your rostering supplier?

There is currently no medical rostering system in place.
