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In the past 6 months, how many patients has your Organisation treated with Ofatumumab?

Ofatumumab has not been prescribed in the Health Board in the past 6 months.

Out of all the patients treated by your Organisation in the last 6 months, how many patients had a diagnosis (Primary or Secondary) of:

- 1 – Relapsing remitting Multiple Sclerosis (SNOMED Code: 426373005)**
- 2 – Primary progressive Multiple Sclerosis (SNOMED Code: 428700003)**
- 3 – Secondary progressive Multiple Sclerosis (SNOMED Code: 425500002)**

In the 6 months period April to September 2021 (to allow for coding completeness), there were 246 patients with a diagnosis code of MS admitted (as an inpatient, daycase or regular day attender) with a total of 507 hospital stays between them. (Patients can course have more than one hospital stay).

Please note, the ICD-10 code of G35.X has been used as the Health Board does not use SNOMED clinical terms within our secondary care hospitals. Due to this, we are unable to break the figures down into the specific type of MS.
