

1) The monthly hospital totals of patients who have died FROM (not 'with') Covid-19/Coronavirus since Jan 2019. From each total, how many patients were unvaccinated?

Please provide the data for patients whose death certificate concluded that Covid-19/Coronavirus was the only cause of fatality.

The Health Board reports every death in our hospitals to Public Health Wales (PHW), this includes all causation factors. Public Health Wales will then perform statistical alignment meeting the definition of a COVID death and the patient place of residence as some of the Health Board area residents may die in other hospitals outside of the Aneurin Bevan Health Board responsibility. All Health Board deaths data is reported on the Public Health Wales website and in the Office of National Statistics (ONS) data.

2) The monthly hospital admission totals for patients who were admitted SOLELY for Covid-19/Coronavirus since Jan 2019 (NOT for another health reason, despite a positive test result). From each total, how many patients were unvaccinated?

Please could you clarify whether all patients admitted to your hospitals are PCR-tested routinely, regardless of symptomatology? And please provide the figures of those who tested positive for both vaccinated and unvaccinated patients.

All patients who are **admitted** to our hospitals are PCR-tested routinely. This does not include patients in our assessment areas who are discharged home and do not stay in hospital.

We are not able to identify patients who were admitted **solely** for COVID. The COVID positive admissions provided are based on the result of a positive COVID (PCR) test. The figure is **not** the number of patients admitted **solely** with COVID and will therefore include patients with other underlying conditions or co-morbidities (including those conditions listed in Questions 3 - 6). Please see attached table. It is important to note that these are absolute numbers and not proportions of the population groups, which is often a more useful indicator.

3) The monthly hospital admission totals for patients who were admitted for flu since Jan 2019. Please see attached table.

4) The monthly hospital admission totals for patients who were admitted for pneumonia since Jan 2019. Please see attached table.

5) The monthly hospital admission totals for patients who were admitted for cardiac issues since Jan 2019. Please see attached table.

6) The monthly hospital admission totals for patients who were admitted for blood clots since Jan 2019. Please see attached table.

Please provide the data for all types of thrombosis, strokes, embolism and blood clotting syndrome disorders.

Please note, the clinical coding for the most recent months may not be complete as the Coding Department are still coding this financial year. Also, the coding is completed once a patient has been discharged, so if the patient has not yet been discharged, they will not be included in this data. The primary diagnosis is the main condition treated or investigated on the first admitting episode of the hospital spell.

7) The monthly figures of deaths and adverse side-effects from the Covid-19/Coronavirus vaccinations.

The Health Board does not hold this information.

There is no requirement to hold or collect this data at a local level. As part of the data entry there is an optional data field to enter hospital address, therefore you may be able to request this information from the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA).

8) The monthly figures of all patient deaths occurring within 28 days of a Covid-19/Coronavirus vaccination. Please see attached table. Please note, the death (within 28 days) is for **any reason** and NOT just due to COVID.
