Please note, the above is a count of the number of patients (as requested) but some of these patients could have had more than one admission during the period. The data on the number of vaccinations was not available for the earlier months requested. We are not able to provide data around the strain or variant of COVID. The deceased numbers are based on any cause/reason and not specifically due to COVID.

In addition, the Health Board reports every death in our hospitals to Public Health Wales (PHW), this includes all causation factors. Public Health Wales will then perform statistical alignment meeting the definition of a COVID death and the patient place of residence as some of the Health Board area residents may die in other hospitals outside of the Aneurin Bevan Health Board responsibility. All Health Board deaths data is reported on the Public Health Wales website and in the Office of National Statistics (ONS) data.
