Out of the 24 ICU beds at Grange University Hospital, please can you tell me how many patients were admitted to hospital only because they were critically ill with Covid-19 between 1st January 2022 to the 14th January 2022? 7

How many patients tested positive for Covid-19 once in the hospital?

0 tested positive in ICU

Please can you tell me of all the critical care patients admitted to Grange University Hospital to the ICU between 1st January 2022 to the 14th January 2022, how many patients have had 1 Covid-19 vaccine? <5\*

Have had 2 Covid-19 vaccines? 8

And have had 2 plus the booster? 23

Please can you also confirm how many unvaccinated patients were in the Grange University Hospital ICU? This means patients that have had no Covid-19 vaccines. 11

Please can you tell me out of the 24 ICU beds at Grange University Hospital between 1st January 2022 to the 14th January 2022 how many have been occupied?

For clarity and for the avoidance of doubt, the first two questions relate to COVID positive patients ONLY, but the last five questions relate to ALL patients admitted to ICU (both COVID and Non-COVID).

\* The Health Board has sought to respond to your request in full; however, due to the small numbers involved, we are unable to provide actual numbers in relation to the vaccination status of all patients as the potential risk of identifying patients becomes significant. Please note that where the numbers are fewer than 5 this has been provided as <5 individuals. We are withholding the detail under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This information is protected by the Data Protection Act 1998, as its disclosure would constitute unfair and unlawful processing and would be contrary to the principles and Schedules 2 and 3 of the Act. This exemption is absolute and therefore there is no requirement to apply the public interest test.
