

The Welsh Government has stated that £166m was made available to set up 19 field hospitals across Wales, albeit none were identified for your Health Board. However, within that funding envelope, it has been confirmed that arrangements were made with existing healthcare providers to access beds during the pandemic. The Welsh Government confirmed the following bed numbers for your Health Board:

## St Joseph's - 36

In terms of your arrangement with St Joseph's, can you please confirm the following:

- 1. The total cost incurred in accessing these beds.
- 2. The date when this arrangement started and when it ended unless it remains in place.
- 3. The number of patients treated through this arrangement.
- 4. Where the arrangement continues to be in place, please confirm the total cost incurred and patients treated up to 31st December 2021.
