I am trying to trace the history of the current Monmouth ambulance station. It appears that the permanent building is now unused or has extremely low use and this situation has continued over a considerable time. The main activities on the site appear confined to the temporary buildings used for paramedic purposes.

I can recall in the 1980's the use of ambulances in Monmouth was called into question but believe that there have been no later uses of these main buildings. I have been told that the site was originally gifted to the then existing health authority for the use of health services in Monmouth" and consequently cannot be used for alternative purposes. However this may be a rumour. Can you please advise, (1) does the "gifting" of the land preclude any other use to how long has the permanent building been out of use; (2) are there any annual costs for heating, lighting or maintenance etc,; (3) are there any possible future uses. I shall be grateful for your help.

Aneurin Bevan University Health Board has no legal interest in the Ambulance Station. The Welsh Ambulance Services NHS Trust would be best placed to provide a response to the questions raised in your request.
