We've been contacted by a constituent, regarding Nevill Hall Hospital. They would like to know what plans are being made to restore services at Nevill Hall Hospital following the Covid-19 pandemic. She is under the impression there are plans for Nevill Hall to become an enhanced district general hospital with expanded day care surgery and possibly the development of a regional centre for expanded eye care.

The Health Board established the role of Nevill Hall Hospital (NHH) as an "Enhanced Local General Hospital (eLGH)" as part of its <u>Clinical Futures Strategy</u> and the establishment of the new Grange University Hospital (GUH) in late 2020.

Since the opening of the GUH, the eLGH roles have been developing across all 3 locations in the Health Board. Each provide, outpatient, diagnostics, planned surgery, emergency care services and inpatient medical beds. Beyond this for each site, the Health Board has some variation/specialisation in what they offer to patients across the Health Board and neighbouring Health Boards. Specifically, for NHH the plan includes additional day surgical care. The Health Board working with partners in Cwm Taf University Health Board and Cardiff & Vale University Health Board in relation to the development of a regional eye care strategy which could include the provision of services at NHH. In addition, the Health Board are also working with Velindre University NHS Trust around the possibility of providing satellite services for cancer patients to receive some of the treatment they currently receive at Velindre, at NHH in the future.
