I would also like to know how many paedriatric x-rays are sent to specialists for review every year on average and how many times the initial findings are shared with agencies (police and social services) when they are not confirmed by a specialist.

The only paediatric x-rays that the Health Board send to external specialists for review are Specialist Paediatric MRI Head reports for babies born with an abnormality as the Health Board does not have the expertise in-house to report on them. We can confirm that none of these findings were shared with agencies and/or social services.
