There has not been a percentage increase in spend on Community Services since 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019.

There has been a percentage decrease in spend on Community Services since 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019. The percentage spend on Community Services as a percentage of the total revenue resource allocation was 9.41% in 2019/20, 8.17% in 2020/21 and 8.49% in 2021/22.

The Health Board has 7 Community Resource Teams which consist of components that cover all of the above.

The Health Board also has a multidisciplinary, Therapy-led Early Supported Discharge (ESD). The service offers up to 12-weeks of community-based rehabilitation for adults discharged from hospital following a stroke. The multidisciplinary ESD team consists of:

- Clinical Psychologists
- Neuro-Physiotherapists
- Occupational Therapists
- Speech and Language Therapists
- Therapy Assistant Practitioners
