Unfortunately, the Health Board is currently unable to provide information about waiting times for ADHD assessment. Since accepting referrals for

ADHD assessment in June 2023, the Health Board has experienced significant demand for assessments that is higher than our capacity to offer assessments.

Welsh Government has recently announced that monies are available for Health Boards and other organisations to bid on to help improve ADHD services. The Health Board is submitting a bid for funding which, if successful, will be used to increase the capacity of resource for the assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of ADHD.
