This data is provided by Welsh Government on a quarterly basis. The data provided, covers all Health Boards in Wales and each Health Boards data is extracted to from this report.

1. Table 1 - Monthly figures for each month Oct 2020 through to Dec 2020 and Jan 2021 through to Mar 2021.

This is condition based mortality outcomes which are published up to September 2020. The original source of this data is from CHKS dated 1st March 2021.

The next update is due to be published by 21<sup>st</sup> June 2021 and will include October, November and December 2020 data.

The data for January 2021 to March 2021, will be available in September 2021.

2. Table 2 - Monthly figures for each month Feb 2021 to April 2021. The original source for the A&E data is "EDDS via Data Mart" provided by Welsh Government. The data provided was run on 17th Feb 2021.

The next update is due to be published by  $21^{st}$  June 2021 and will include February, March and April 2021.

- **3.** Please confirm normal publication schedule for each of Table 1 and 2. Information is published on a quarterly basis.
- 4. What are the established reasons for Grange University Hospital having a mortality rate more than twice of both the Wales average and other ABUHB hospitals?

The mortality rates are calculated on a rolling 12-month basis and at the time of the report The Grange University Hospital had been open for 2½ months and therefore, the figures are not representative for comparison with others over a 12-month period. It is anticipated that this figure will change and will reflect improvements over the year.
