- 1. How many people on the COVID-19 temporary register were contacted to work at your board from the following months:
 - a) October 2020?
 - b) November 2020?
 - c) December 2020?

Twenty (20) people were contacted during the months specified.

The Health Board is unable to provide the data by month as temporary registrations were recorded on our ESR system as a lapsed registration and not by date. The twenty (20) people were the same people throughout with no additions/reductions made. The Health Board did not contact these people as they were working as and when required throughout the pandemic via the Resource Bank. Resource Bank staff are able to select the shift that they would like to work from the shifts available and have no contracted hours.

- 2. Do you know why the remaining registrants were not contacted? All the registrants available to the Health Board were contacted.
- 3. Of those you contacted to work via the register, how many said yes from the following months:
 - a) October 2020?
 - b) November 2020?
 - c) December 2020?

Five (5) of the twenty (20) people in total on the COVID-19 temporary register worked for the Health Board during these months. Work was made available to all via our Resource Bank which allows individuals to self-select the shifts that they wish to work.

Shifts remain available to the remaining people as and when demand to fill shifts is required. The number of shifts undertaken by the five (5) people during the months specified is indicated below:
