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How many people have died in your hospitals from Covid 19 alone?

As in they died ONLY due to Covid 19. I can see the figures that you publish online, but these are deaths within 28 days of a positive Covid test, so they could have died purely or partly from other causes. I just want to know the exact figure from 1st February 2020 until the 20th December 2020 of people that have died due to Covid 19 and not anything else please.

Can you also please provide the number of people who died partly due to Covid eg not those who had had a positive test and then died in a car crash (as happened to someone I know) but where Covid was a cause of their death. For the same time period.

The Health Board reports every death in our hospitals to Public Health Wales (PHW), this includes all causation factors. Public Health Wales will then perform statistical alignment meeting the definition of a COVID death and the patient place of residence as some of the Health Board area residents may die in other hospitals outside of the Aneurin Bevan Health Board responsibility. All Health Board deaths data is reported on the Public Health Wales website and in the Office of National Statistics (ONS) data.
