- 1. Can you advise on the percentage of midwife-led birth (I.e not consultant led) delivered at Ysbyty Fawr without the need for an unplanned consultant or transfer to another hospital.**

21% of midwife-led care women arriving at the Birth Centre were transferred to the Labour Ward at the Grange University Hospital (GUH) for medical intervention.

There were 0% of intrapartum still births during this time. (Intrapartum stillbirths is when a baby was thought to be alive at the start of labour but was born, beyond 37 weeks of gestation, with no signs of life.)
