

It has brought to my attention, that there appears to be a very high occurrence of young people being delivered to Paediatrics with varying degrees of suffering leukaemia. Is that caused by chemical leeching of any kind or emission of noxious or toxic smoke or team?

- 1. Could you provide a report on the number of children that have been diagnosed with leukaemia at the Grange University Hospital and whether the origin of the disease has been captured? For the benefit of locating the source.**

There were 8 patients aged under 18 admitted to Grange University Hospital with a primary or secondary diagnosis of Leukaemia since it opened in November in 2020.

Please note that it is not possible to identify when and where the patient was diagnosed as the initial date/location of diagnosis is not recorded on the system. The figures do not include any patients diagnosed in outpatients, A&E or primary care who have not been admitted to an ABUHB hospital. The Health Board does not capture the origin or cause of the leukaemia.

We also recommend that you contact the Welsh Cancer Surveillance and Intelligence Unit (WCISU) as they may hold more data on this and provide further help. We have provided a link below.
