



What is a Neurodevelopmental Assessment?

It is an assessment that helps identify if your child has a neurodevelopmental condition such as Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) or Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)

This is what to expect from the CAMHS Neuro-developmental Service

The first part of the assessment if for one clinician to complete a developmental history with the parent.

You will then be invited to being your child for a face to face clinical observation through play.

If further assessment is needed a professional may go out to your child's school or you may be asked to come back for a further appointment.

If we are unable to reach a formulation at this stage, we will consult colleagues our multi-disciplinary team for their clinical opinion, and if appropriate they may continue with futher assessments.

When the assessment is finished, parents will be contacted via a telephone appointment to provide the feedback. This is where we will discuss the outcome of the assessment and your child may or may not be given a diagnosis of ASD or ADHD. The team will provide you with resources/ signpost or refer you to helpful services.
