Unless you have not been resolving other freedom of information requests during the last 9 months, then it would appear you have specifically downgraded my individual request without sufficient reason. This will of course become clear when the freedom of information disclosure log has eventually been updated.

I am afraid to say that given the obvious failure to meet your previous aspiration/deadline or even provide an ongoing update, I have limited confidence that you will meet this further deadline.

As a result I would be grateful if you could now ensure I receive by email or hard copy, all the information requested without any further delay.

As previously advised work is underway to reinstate the Disclosure Log on the Health Board's website by July 2022. The Health Board has received over 1000 Freedom of Information requests for the period March 2020 to March 2022 therefore, in order to comply with your request, the Health Board has established that this would exceed the appropriate costs limit under Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 which is currently £450. As you will be aware this is not an exemption which requires us to consider the application of the public interest test. We have calculated that it would take in excess of 18 hours to scan and collate each request.

However, if you would like to provide details of a specific subject within the time period requested, or restrict the time period, the Health Board will endeavour to provide this information, pending publication of the full Disclosure Log.
