Q1 In response to my first question, 'how many people are currently receiving support from ABUHB's post-covid recovery team for long covid', I was told that there were 99 people on the waiting list and 115 on the follow-up list.

Does this mean that the post-Covid recovery team currently is not supporting any patients, or is it that the post-Covid recovery team's role is only to forward patients on to other services? Some clarity on this would be appreciated.

The Health Board has a multidisciplinary team who are directly involved in the treatment of patients (114 in total to date).

Q2 Additionally, in response to my second question, 'how many people have received support from ABUHB's post-covid recovery team for long covid' since April 2020, I was provided with a breakdown of total patient numbers from the core Covid recovery service, post-ITU rehab and education patient programme.

Would it be possible to get some more information on what the roles of each of these services are and what they actually entail?

The services include Neurology, Cardiology, Respiratory, Physiotherapy, Exercise Referral, Psychology, Occupational Therapy interventions. These are delivered in one-to-one sessions. Sessions are tailored to a patient's individual circumstances and health condition. Development is also underway to establish group programmes.
