Complete referral form.	Create single room capacity on C6W
Request patient remains at home until WAST transport arrives.	Book WAST transport. Inform WAST and C6W nurse in charge of potential case & arrange transport to level 0 at RGH . Request a nurse to meet the patient & ambulance crew at level 0.
Contact Bed Management 01633 234682 to hand over patient details & arrange direct admission to single room on C6W . Bed management will arrange WAST transport.	Request WAST to give patient & anyone accompanying patient a surgical mask to wear.
	Contact Respiratory Medical Team or out of hours Medical Registrar/SPR on call.
	2 x THROAT SWABS FOLLOWING DISCUSSION WITH PUBLIC HEALTH WALES. Request Covid-19 testing and indicate High Risk on the request forms for all respiratory samples.
