SELF PRESENT	AMBULANCE PRESENTATION	GP REFERRAL
Receptionist to ask patient & anyone accompanying the patient to wear a surgical mask	Give patient a surgical mask to wear. Patient to remain in ambulance until direct admission to Assessment Room B . (<i>Follow step 3 as per SELF PRESENT option</i>).	Inform Paediatric Team in Children's Assessment Unit 01633 656020
Notify Triage nurse or ENP to isolate patient immediately in Assessment Room B . Door to remain closed.	If patient becomes critically unwell requiring resuscitation, DO NOT bring into Resus. Patient to remain on ambulance & attended to by Senior Doctor, Senior Nurse & ambulance crew.	CAU to contact Paediatric Coordinator to create a single room on age appropriate ward.
Designated Nurse & Doctor to attend to patient wearing PPE:- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fluid resistant surgical mask Thumb loop gown Tight fitting gloves Eye protection Disposable surgical cap 	If patient self presents & requires resuscitation, transfer to Assessment Room B .	Arrange WAST transport to level 0 at RGH . Contact bed management on 01633 234682 to request a nurse from the receiving ward to meet the patient & ambulance crew at level 0.
Take history & perform baseline observations.	Notify:- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nurse in charge Microbiologist 01633 234463 or out of hours via hospital switchboard 01633 234234 Infection Prevention 01633 238101 	Give patient a surgical mask to wear. Patient to remain in ambulance until direct admission to age appropriate ward. (<i>Follow steps 3 as per SELF PRESENT option</i>).
2 x THROAT SWABS FOLLOWING DISCUSSION WITH PUBLIC HEALTH WALES. Request Covid-19 testing and indicate High Risk on the request forms for all respiratory samples.		
Remove PPE (except mask) inside the room. Dispose in double orange biohazard bag. Wash hands thoroughly. Leave room & remove mask. Wash hands again.
