Does child require Critical Care?

If there are clinical concerns about a patient's condition, a critical care opinion is always available for review or discussion, and where necessary admission to critical care.

YES

Contact Works & Estates to disable air conditioning before transferring child to main theatre annex. Child to wear surgical mask.
Inform PICU of situation.

Patient no longer requires ventilation.
Transfer to single room on age appropriate ward

NO

Child to wear a surgical mask.
Transfer child to single room with ensuite on age appropriate ward.

Patient is confirmed Covid-19 positive.
Remain in single room on age appropriate ward

HEALTH CARE STAFF TO WEAR THE FOLLOWING PPE:-

Fluid resistant surgical mask

Thumb loop gown

Tight fitting gloves

Eye protection

Disposable surgical cap
