Does patient require Critical Care?

If there are clinical concerns about a patient's condition, a critical care opinion is always available for review or discussion, and where necessary admission to critical care.

YES

Patient to wear a surgical mask
Transfer patient to single room on
ITU

NO

Patient to wear surgical mask
Transfer patient to single room with ensuite
facilities on **C6W, RGH**
Arrange transfer via bed management & WAST

Patient is confirmed **Covid-19 positive**.
Remain in single room with ensuite facilities on **C6W**

Patient has recovered, but still requires rehabilitation – if transferring to a community hospital patient must be isolated as length of infectivity time is still unknown.

HEALTH CARE STAFF TO WEAR THE FOLLOWING PPE:-

Fluid resistant surgical mask

Thumb loop gown

Tight fitting gloves

Eye protection

Disposable surgical cap
