

## Pathway for the management of suspected Covid-19

### MATERNITY SERVICES ROYAL GWENT & NEVILL HALL HOSPITAL

Potential case of Covid-19 (**Coronavirus**) identified by midwife or GP. Patient presenting with ACUTE respiratory symptoms OR fever with no other symptoms within 14 days after travel from **China, Hong Kong, Japan, Macau, Malaysia, Republic of Korea, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand, Iran, South Korea, Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Italy**

If well enough, patient to be transferred to **Royal Gwent Hospital via WAST**.
