Please could you confirm if your organization has any local guidelines for the treatment for the following conditions of the eye. If you have local guidelines available, please could I request a copy.

- Neovascular age related macular degeneration (wet AMD)
- Age-related Macular Degeneration (AMD)
- Diabetic macular oedema (DMO)
- Macular oedema secondary to central retinal vein occlusion (CRVO)
- Macular oedema secondary to branch retinal vein occlusion (BRVO)
- Choroidal neovascularization (CNV) associated with pathological myopia
- Vitreomacular traction (VMT)
- Non-infectious uveitis

If no local guidelines are available, please can you confirm if any national guidelines are used for the treatment for these conditions.

I can confirm that the Health Board follows guidance from NICE and the Royal College of Ophthalmologists for the local treatment of:

- Neovascular age related macular degeneration (wet AMD)
- Age-related Macular Degeneration (AMD)
- Diabetic macular oedema (DMO)
- Macular oedema secondary to central retinal vein occlusion (CRVO)
- Macular oedema secondary to branch retinal vein occlusion (BRVO)
- Choroidal neovascularization (CNV) associated with pathological myopia

We do not treat vitreomacular traction in Aneurin Bevan University Health Board. Patients who meet NICE guidance TA297 (VMT with no epiretinal membrane and stage 2 macular hole) who wish to be assessed for treatment are referred for vitreoretinal opinion by Cardiff and Vale University Health Board.

Non-infectious Uveitis is treated with local steroids (Triamcenolone and Ozurdex) and systemic steroids and systemic second line Immunosuppression including Mycophenolate mofetil, Tacrolimus, Methotrexate and Azathioprine.
