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1. Details of when your Blood Glucose Test Strip (BGTS) is up for formulary review and email contact information for your Formulary and Medicines Management Teams in order to provide details of recent price reductions on FP10

All Health Boards in NHS Wales, in conjunction with NWSSP Procurement Services have completed a procurement process to rationalise the choice of blood glucose meters for patients with diabetes. Suppliers on the national drug tariff for these items were invited to participate, and were subsequently evaluated on their technical and commercial capabilities.

The meters awarded are as follows:
