Dosing Guidelines Based on Weight for Adults



Oral Paracetamol Preparations

In response to a number of queries from nursing homes concerning the appropriate dose of paracetamol when considering residents, the suggested oral dose of paracetamol 500mg tablets are:

Resident Weight	Suggested Dosage
Over 50kg	Take ONE or TWO tablets up to four times a day when required
Between 40-50kg	Take ONE or TWO tablets up to THREE times a day when required
Under 40kg	Take ONE tablet up to four times a day when required

The Homes should ensure that all other residents who fit the weight profile and who are on paracetamol and or medication's that contain paracetamol, such as co-codamol are identified and any remedial action taken, such as clarifying with the GP that they are satisfied with the dosing regimen.

These are just guidelines, the principle rationale for the appropriate dose of paracetamol is one that succeeds in relieving pain.

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
