Welcome to the fourth joint edition of the Tredegar Health and Wellbeing Centre newsletter from Kier Construction Western and Wales, in partnership with Aneurin Bevan University Health Board (ABUHB).

We are pleased to announce that the site has officially been named as The Bevan Health & Wellbeing Centre.

The new facility, which is due to be completed in Summer 2023, will provide a comprehensive range of Primary Care, Community, Social Care and Wellbeing services together in one place for residents.

Following a public discussion on the official name of the centre, The Bevan Health & Wellbeing Centre was chosen by Ann Lloyd CBE, Chair of Aneurin Bevan University Health Board, and Glyn Jones, former Interim Chief Executive, from a selection of suggested titles.

Ann Lloyd CBE, Chair of Aneurin Bevan University Health Board, said:

"We received some excellent name suggestions for the new building, but The Bevan Health and Wellbeing Centre seemed the most fitting for a centre built in the hometown of the founder of the NHS."

The site has changed dramatically since photographs were last taken back in November 2021, with an impressive steel frame and concrete flooring now in place. To keep people up to date with the development we have recently taken some new photos and video footage of the site 'beyond the hoarding' to document the construction progress.

Project Update

Work on the new Health Centre is progressing, the envelope works (cladding, brickwork and windows) have moved forward and are coming along well with the scaffold completed around the north, east and south elevations to facilitate the works. The flat roofing areas are completed and the pitched roof construction has commenced with the timber and insulation layers, the next phase of works to these will be the a further layer of insulation, felt and batten followed by the slates moving into December and through to January. As the building becomes weather tight with the pitched roof work moving forward the internal drylining and first fix mechanical and electrical services will be commencing as the first elements of the fit out works.

Whilst works are ongoing on the Tredegar Health and Wellbeing Centre, we will still be providing services as usual and we will keep you updated on arrangements as we transition to the new build.

We partnered up with architects IBI to deliver a design session at Deighton Primary School, whereby students got a sneak peek at what the new Health & Wellbeing Centre will look like. They also designed their 'dream school' mimicking methods used on the new Tredegar build.



Kier are also proud to have donated a defibrillator device to a community group in Ebbw Vale following an unsuspecting cardiac arrest of a young person in the area. The device has been registered on the automated external defibrillator (AED) website and available to use within the community.



The Tredegar site team welcomed 15 Coleg Gwent bricklaying students to site in December. This was a great introduction to their future trade, marking the students first time on a construction site. The group learned about career pathways, bricklaying techniques and the use of reclaimed bricks in the new build, preserving the history of the old hospital in the new Health & Wellbeing Centre.
