



What do you think about having the service for Acute Medicine (Acute Medical Take) at Gloucestershire Royal Hospital?


Acute medicine is treatment and assessment for things like very bad headaches, chest pain, pneumonia or asthma.



These are operations on the gut which is where you digest your food. People have their operation and go home the same day.



A Hub is the main place something happens, and a Spoke is linked to the Hub.

IGIS is Image-guided Interventional Surgery, this is where cameras are used inside the body so the surgeon can see what is going on.

Trauma Surgery is where people need operations after they have been injured in an accident.




