

Physician Response Unit – Discharge Advice

The Physician Response Unit is a joint service run by the Welsh Ambulance Service Trust and the Emergency Department (A&E) at the Grange University Hospital. The PRU team consists of a paramedic and a senior emergency medicine doctor.

What we do:

The PRU team will do a full medical assessment in the patient's home including a range of tests if needed.

After assessment the PRU team will advise what to do next. This may involve treatment at home, follow up with your GP or further assessment and treatment in hospital.
