Who is it for?

This group is aimed at parents of **children aged four months to 6 years old** or carers who would like to understand their child's emotional world and strengthen their relationship.



What is the group about?

Parenting can be one of the best and hardest jobs. All parents want to do the best for their children but this is not always easy. Sometimes, we feel stuck with certain behaviours and nothing we do seems to work.

Most parents who attend feel worried about being part of a group but afterwards tell us that sharing and connecting with other parents has been one of the most valuable things for them.



How will it work?

Each week we will think about a different topic using short videos, handouts and chatting together to help you to understand:

- ➤ How to help your child cope with their feelings
- > How to help your child feel secure in their relationships
- > How to understand and respond to difficult behaviours
- How to improve your child's self-esteem and feel better about themselves
- > How to understand your child's emotional world
