Who are the Child Development Advisory Service?

We are a home based service for pre-school children who have developmental delay.

We work together with you and your child using play to promote development.



What we do

- Visit you and your child at home at a time to suit you
- Link with other services in supporting you
- Use a structured assessment to think about your child's development
- Bring toys and teach you skills and ways of encouraging learning through play
- Help you enjoy time with your child

Your Role

- Avoid smoking when we are in the room
