OCT – Optical Coherent Topography is when we take a scan of the back of your eye to provide a permanent record of your eye condition.

What happens during the test?

During the test different pictures will be taken of the back of your eye.

How soon can I go home after the test?

You can go straight home after the test but your vision will be blurred for a few hours after the procedure.
