

Information for Patients attending the Maxillofacial and Oral Surgery Day Unit

Surgical Procedure under Local Anaesthetic and Intravenous Sedation

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Before your appointment

- 1. Do not eat anything from Midnight prior to your appointment this includes chewing gum and boiled sweets.
- 2. You may have **sips** of **clear tap water** up until 3 hours before your appointment time
- 3. Please do not wear makeup, nail varnish, or false nails

Please bring with you:-

Current tablets or medicines.

It is essential that you have organised:-

- Transport home (not public transport).
- A responsible adult to attend with you, take you home, and then be available to provide 24 hour care from time of discharge.

On admission

- 1. You will be admitted by a nurse, and seen by the clinical team.
- 2. Before your operation you will be asked to sign a consent form. There will be an opportunity for you to ask questions prior to signing; this is to ensure that you completely understand the proposed treatment.
- 3. Children attending under age 16 will require a parent / legal quardian to sign their consent form.
- 4. You will be taken into theatre and connected to monitoring equipment so it is suggested that you wear a short sleeved garment with a button up front.
- 5. The sedation is given by a small needle in the back of the hand or in your arm. It will make you drowsy but will not put you to sleep.
- 6. You will be given protective glasses to wear and covered with sterile paper drapes.
- 7. The surgeon will then give you local anaesthetic to numb the area before carrying out your operation.
- 8. During your surgery you may be given oxygen through small nasal tubes.

Following surgery

- 1. You will remain in the department until you are fit for discharge; this is approximately 1 hour following sedation.
- 2. For the 24 hours following discharge:
- You should not drive
- You should not handle any mechanical / domestic appliances
- You should not sign any legal documents

- 3. When you get home, you will need to rest.
- 4. A follow up appointment will be given to you if necessary
